- Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 weighted scale

- Letter of recommendation

Paul Quinn is test-optional for the 2024-2025 application cycle. Applicants who have taken the ACT and/or SAT are welcome to submit scores to supplement their applications, but scores will not be required for an application to be considered for admission review.

A standard score of 170 is required for regular admission, anything below would be considered for conditional admission.

2.0 URBAN WORK COLLEGE MODEL

4 STUDENT CREDENTIALS & CHECK-IN PROCESS

You will receive access to an Office365 email account and CANVAS (online learning environment) beginning in April. Information will be sent directly to your personal email address. Upon receipt, please log into your new pqc.edu email address to begin the online check-in process via CANVAS.

5 SUBMIT YOUR VAX RECORDS

All students attending in-person courses and activities on-campus <u>must</u> be fully vaccinated against meningitis. We advise students to do this as early as possible to ensure a smooth registration process. Meningitis vaccines must be administered at least ten (10) days prior to campus move-in. Records must be submitted electronically via the CANVAS check-in process.

COMPLETE THE FAFSA® FORM

We encourage you to submit your federal financial aid application, which can be either a FAFSA or TASFA. You will want to add Paul Quinn to your application by using our school code: 003602. Your financial aid award letter will be emailed to your personal email address after you submit your WE/Me Online Application and resume. All financial aid questions can be sent to: finaid@pqc.edu.

SUBMIT OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT(S)

Official transcripts must bear the embossed or raised school seal, date and signature from the Registrar or School Administrator and paper copies should remain in the unopened, sealed envelope until it is presented to a Paul Quinn staff member.

REQUEST LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

One (1) letter of recommendation is required as part of the application. This letter must come from a non-relative of the student and should come from a counselor, teacher from Junior or Senior year of High School, coach, advisor, and/or faith leader.

SUBMIT RESUME

As a Work College, we aim to build work-ready leaders for tomorrow. Building a resume is a skill you will need for our process but also for future employment. All students are required to submit a resume as part of their admission. For resume guidance, scan the QR code on the right.
