
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


FSA ID Username and Password Reset

1. Go to studentaid.gov and click on Log In.




2. Scroll down and go to Forgot My Username | Forgot My Password.






3. After you click Forgot My Username, you may retrieve it by using your Email address or phone number you utilized to create your Federal Student Aid Identification (FSA ID).



4. You have four options below to choose from where the database can send you a verification code. This process is needed to verify if you are the registered account owner. Please see explanations below:

Retrieve Your Username

A) If you utilized an authenticator application like Google Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator, Authy, LastPass, and Duo Mobile, insert the data requested and follow the steps listed on this link.



B) If you registered and verified your mobile number: Click on Text a secure code to my mobile phone. Enter the Mobile Phone Number utilized when you created your account and the account owner's Date of Birth then press continue.

Enter the code sent to you via text then continue.





You will then successfully retrieve your username.

C) Enter the email address you registered your account with: Click on Email me a secure code. Enter the Email Address and the account owner's Date of Birth.

D) If you no longer have access to either phone number or email utilized when you created the FSA ID or do not remember them: Click on Answer my challenge questions. Enter the data requested and continue.

It will then prompt you to answer the questions you selected. After answering correctly, you will then successfully retrieve your username.





Repeat these steps if you do not remember your password.



IRS Tax Data Extraction to FAFSA

For the 2025-2026 FAFSA, the IRS extracts financial information directly from a tax return through a secure electronic process called the "FUTURE Act Direct Data Exchange (FA-DDX)" which allows the Department of Education to access necessary tax details from the IRS.

By providing consent on the FAFSA application, this process will essentially be importing most income and tax information directly onto the form. This means the applicant and/or contributor usually does not need to manually enter their tax information, making the process faster and more accurate.




- 1. Note, not all tax questions may be answered. Please answer them to the best of your knowledge by utilizing your tax return (1040 form).
- 2. The final step is to Sign & Submit your application for both student and parent (if applicable).




Requesting a Tax Return Transcript

1. If you are selected for verification and need to request an IRS Tax Return Transcript, go to www.irs.gov and click on Get Your Tax Record.



2. You have two options to choose from.

Requesting a Tax Return Transcript Online or getting a Transcript by Mail.






3. If you choose to Get Transcript Online, Create an Account or Log In to your IRS account to retrieve the **Return Tax Transcript** for the year the financial aid representative requested from you and/or parents.

You may submit the copy via the DocuSign Form that was sent to you or via email at finaid@pqc.edu



4. If you choose to get a transcript through mail, fill out the form and then choose the **Return Tax Transcript** for the year the financial aid representative requested from you and/or parents.

After you have received them by mail (within 5-10 business days), you may submit a picture of <u>each</u> tax page (front and back) via the DocuSign Form that was sent to you or via email at <u>finaid@pqc.edu</u>






If you are unable to obtain them online, you have two other options.


- You may request one through the IRS phone number at 1-800-829-1040 and click through the options and request a Tax Return Transcript.

2. Go to the Loans and Grants dropdown then click on Loan Entrance Counseling.






3. Scroll down and click on Log in to Start based on your student status.

Your school may have different entrance counseling requirements. Check with your school's financial aid office to be sure that the counseling on this Web site satisfies your school's entrance counseling requirements.








7. You have 6 modules to complete in this application. Click Start to continue with the first module.





Our director should receive and import the completed Loan Entrance Counseling within - 2-3 business days.






Master Promissory Note

2. Go to the **Loans and Grants** dropdown then click on **Master Promissory Note (MPN)**.






3. Scroll down and click on **Start** based on the loan type you are seeking.

5. Complete all 5 steps for the Master Promissory Note application.



PLUS Loan

1. For the parent or graduate student wanting to take out a PLUS Loan, Go to studentaid.gov.




2. Go to the **Loans and Grants** dropdown then click on **PLUS Loan: Grad PLUS and Parent Plus**.

The Parent PLUS Loan is commonly used at Paul Quinn as a resource for parents to help fund their student's education. If a parent is willing to apply for the PLUS Loan a credit check will be processed by the Department of Education.


- If approved, the PLUS Loan will be taken under the parent's terms and conditions.
- If denied, the student will be eligible to access additional unsubsidized loan. However, funding is limited.

The Graduate PLUS Loan is a student loan issued by the U.S. Department of Education. It's designed to help graduate and professional students finance their education.

- 4. Scroll down and click on Log in to Start.
 - For the Parent Plus Loan, please make sure you log in using your FSA ID and password. **Not the students.**
 - For the Graduate or Professional Student Plus Loan, log in using your (the student's) FSA ID and password.
 - *Go to pages 3-6 to reset or retrieve your FSA ID and password. *
- 5. Complete the PLUS application.

If the **PLUS Loan decision is approved**, complete the PLUS Master Promissory Note associated with your type (parent or graduate student).

After submitting the **Parent PLUS Loan application**, and the loan decision is denied, the student can qualify for additional unsubsidized loans.

Please provide us (<u>finaid@pqc.edu</u>) with a screenshot of the accepted or denial notice for tracking purposes and for our director to package the PLUS Loan accordingly.
