COMPLETE A 2027-2028 FAFSA



One of the most important next steps is for you to complete a FAFSA and add Paul Quinn College (School Code: 00360200). Without a completed FAFSA that includes the Paul Quinn School Code, we will be unable to send you a Financial Aid Offer letter outlining your available aid, scholarships, and out-of-pocket costs.

REVIEW YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARD LETTER



Check your email for your personal login credentials to your Self-Service student portal. Once we receive your completed FAFSA information we will generate a Financial Aid Offer Letter for you to review in the portal. This letter will outline the cost-of-attendance and any aid/scholarships that you may be eligible for.

SUBMIT YOUR ONLINE COMMITMENT FORM & ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT



The online Commitment Form and non-refundable enrollment deposit are both required to guarantee your spot in the class and in housing. If you intend to attend Paul Quinn for the 2027-2028 school year, you will need to log into your application portal. In your application portal, on the left-hand side you will see an area for Supplemental Forms. Here you will need to complete the complete your Commitment Form. Completing the Commitment Form and paying the deposit is mandatory for all new incoming students, even if you plan on living at home and being an online student. Without a completed Commitment Form, we will not be able to hold your spot in the class, Summer Bridge, or housing. Housing is limited and will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis for new students. We highly recommend submitting your Commitment Form as soon as possible!

SCHEDULE YOUR VACCINES



If you want to be an in-person student and/or live in college housing, you will be required to submit vaccine documentation for Meningitis. Due to the state mandated 10-day incubation period, vaccines need to be taken a minimum of 10 days before in order to be able to meet the document submission deadline of Thursday, June 3, 2027. Vaccine record upload will occur through the CANVAS Check-in Course which students will be given access to after committing. Students that miss the Thursday, June 3, 2027 deadline will not be allowed to move into college housing due to the 10-day incubation period required for Meningitis.

SAVE THE DATE: SUMMER BRIDGE



Any student that wants to enroll as an in-person student must attend Summer Bridge. The 2027 Summer Bridge Program will take place from Sunday, June 13, 2027 through Friday, July 23, 2027. learn more about the program by scanning the QR code.
